

Changes to CFP Board-Registered Continuing Education Effective 1/1/2011

Graduate Degree Courses

Effective 1/1/2011 the College's graduate degree courses will no longer be registered for continuing education (CE) credit with CFP Board. While the College's graduate degree courses continue to qualify for CFP Board CE credit according to CFP Board's CE standards, the College has elected to discontinue its formal registration of these courses with CFP Board. Instead, successful completion of any of the College's graduate degree courses can be [self-reported](#) to CFP Board by CFP® certificants.

Because the College recognizes the value-added benefit of receiving CFP Board CE credit for successfully completing one of its graduate degree courses, starting 1/1/2011 we will reimburse our students for the \$20 per course [review fee](#) assessed by CFP Board. To request reimbursement of the \$20 CFP Board review fee, please submit a written request along with a copy of the CFP Board's Self-Reported CE Course Review fee [receipt](#) to fax number 602-626-2466, or email the documents to cffpssc@cftp.edu.

Graduate degree courses successfully completed prior to 1/1/2011 will automatically be reported to CFP Board provided we have the last four digits of your social security number on file.

Professional Designation Programs (AAMS®, ADPASM, APMASM, AWMA®, CMFC®, CRPC®, CRPS®, RP®)

Effective 1/1/2011 the number of CFP Board CE credits awarded for completion of one of the College's professional designation programs will change from 45 (5 for ADPASM) to 28. Credit will automatically be reported to CFP Board provided we have the last four digits of your social security number on file.
